Stallion service provided will be by **warm AI and fresh-cooled or frozen semen only**. Stud Fee does not include collection costs of \$400.00 per collection (including overnight shipping by Federal Express or UPS only), which must be paid by mare owner to Creekside Morgans LLC

before semen is shipped.

Stud fee includes **Live Foal Guarantee** (“live foal” defined herein as foal who stands and nurses on day of birth) and return privilege for the specified mare only. BREEDING SHED: Stallion services for the 2014 season will be provided, between February 15, 2014, and June 30, 2014. Contact: Scott Neidlinger, Breeding Manager, with any extenuating circumstances regarding breeding needs that cannot be handled within the established service calendar.

COLLECTION COSTS AND PROCEDURES:

Collection Procedures: Collection of stallion will be performed by Stallion Owner or Owner’s Representative at a facility of their choice or Creekside Morgans LLC, 60529 State Route 415, Avoca NY 14809-9540. Contact: Scott Neidlinger, Breeding Manager at (607) 967-4715 or (607)-343-3324 at least 24 hours before requesting semen shipment, to alert us that the mare is cycling. E-Mail to sneidlinger@frontiernet.net or mail all required veterinary information, certificates or culture results on the mare’s breeding fitness before requesting first semen shipment.

Collection costs: \$400.00 per collection. This \$400.00 fee includes overnight shipment of semen within USA to mare owner by Fedex or UPS. It is the mare owner’s responsibility to return equitainer within seven days of receipt; return shipment of equitainer is at mare owner’s cost. If equitainer is not returned within seven days of receipt, a late fee of \$50.00 per day for up to 10 days and/or replacement cost of equitainer will be paid by mare owner.

Shipment by Air Counter to Counter: If mare owner elects to have semen shipped same-day, counter to counter, a \$75.00 delivery charge will be added to the standard \$400 collection fee to cover airport delivery and all same-day air costs of the semen shipment must be paid by mare owner, cost to be determined by or at time of shipment. Same day semen shipment by air carrier is available **only** at Mare owner’s cost. The Mare Owner is responsible for all veterinary charges related to pregnancy of the Mare.

Live Foal Guarantee: Should said mare not produce a live foal (stands and nurses on day of birth), the Mare Owner shall be entitled to a return breeding during the same season or next season on the same terms. All ensuing Collection Fees are required. A statement of the details of the foal’s death by a licensed veterinarian must follow within 10 days of foal’s death or this guarantee

becomes null and void.

All parties agree that the semen shipped under this contract is to be used for said Mare only, or a substitute mare approved by Stallion Owner as provided in this contract. Substitute mare will be approved based on pedigree, health, and breeding history as determined by stallion owners or their representative.

The Mare Owner certifies that the Designated Veterinarian practices reproduction as a regular part of his/her practice and is available for palpation, cultures, A.I., and other necessary procedures, and has consented to oversee the breeding of said mare on a regular basis. The Designated Veterinarian agrees to the following conditions:

- a) Will examine said Mare within 25 days prior to semen shipment and certify in writing that said Mare is free of infection and is in good breeding condition.
- b) Will mail or fax to Breeding Manager, Scott Neidlinger, written results of a uterine culture taken within 45 days before semen shipment. Culture must be processed by a certified laboratory. First shipment of semen will not be sent unless a) and b) have been completed.
- c) The provisions of a) and b) must be repeated for any Mare failing to settle within two cycles after shipment of semen has commenced.
- d) Will examine said Mare for pregnancy 30-55 days after the last insemination and mail/fax results to the Stallion Owner.
- e) Failure to conform to the above will nullify all guarantees and no further semen will be shipped.

The Stallion Owner assumes responsibility only to deliver live semen in viable condition at the time of shipment to the Mare Owner. The Stallion Owner will ship semen up to two times per estrus cycle at times arranged with the Designated Veterinarian, and will repeat these shipments for up to three cycles.

Only if said Mare fails to become pregnant after **three** cycles, shall Mare Owner have the right to substitute a different owned mare (Substitute Mare), in which case the Substitute Mare must be fully identified, results of a new uterine culture and breeding exam forwarded to the Stallion Owner for approval before insemination may take place. Approval of substitute mare by Breeding Manager is required before semen is shipped.

Mare Owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of said Mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to her whether by death, disease, injury, infection, or by any cause whatsoever and, therefore, agrees to hold the Stallion Owner (or any person associated with said Owner) harmless for any and all damages associated therewith.

Mare Owner understands that both said Mare and resulting Foal must be blood-typed and or DNA typed by AMHA, if Morgan, or validated in accordance with regulatory procedures of other

Registry, prior to registration of Foal, and any Foal conceived in any manner not complying with this Contract or governing registry regulations will not be eligible for registration.

Should the above named Stallion become unfit for service before the conditions of this agreement are met, this Contract will become null and void.
